



## Notice of Race GPSC “Lake Huron Cruise Race” 2018 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

If you are interested in getting North for cruising or you are interested in a “Fun Casual Race,” this may be of interest. The Grosse Pointe Sail Club is continuing the tradition and will get the race started on **Sunday, July 15, 2018** from Port Huron. The race has two stop-overs ([Harbor Beach](#) and [Harrisville](#)) and finishes at [Presque Isle Harbor](#). There is no need to sail all night or in extremely bad weather. No need to sit with no wind or sail on a stripped out boat. You can even tow a dinghy or run your engine. All the boats rest each evening for cocktails, dinner, and a good night’s sleep. The next race segment will start the following morning. The finish is at Presque Isle Harbor with a celebratory awards brunch the morning after the finish. This year, the Race Committee has planning under way for a cruise through the North Channel under the guidance of experienced North Channel cruisers.
