### **Susan Kaufmann Sailing Experience**

Here's my abbreviated resume. I have well over 1000 miles at sea. I'm 65 but in good health/shape. I have sailed on Lake Michigan beginning about 2008. I have 5 weeks plus of Caribbean sailing from 2011 to present. In 2018 with Girls for Sail I sailed from St Lucia to Martinique to Dominica and back. We went about 300 miles. In 2019 I sailed for 10 days with an all women's crew out of Antigua. We raced for 2 days in the Jolly Harbor regatta. We finished 4th. I have a competent crew credential from the royal yacht association. I sailed with Patti (see below) on all the Caribbean sails except in 2014 when she received her Day Skipper credential. I'm more comfortable assisting rather than helming though I have helmed in high winds and seas. I also make a great Gin and Tonic and a killer wild mushroom risotto.
