SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2024 DRYA SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, located at: www.drya.org.

Racing rule 6.1 is modified as follows:

6.1. ENTRIES - This regatta is open to boats registered in the 2024 DRYA counter series and to sail yachts (Invited Boats) owned by members of the Grosse Pointe Sail Club. Invited boats shall register with the GPSC by August 5, 2024 to compete in the GPSC Club JAM Class (Start #7) and shall sail race #1 only). Invitations may be obtained from and submitted to: franklinpoupore@gmail.com. PJAM or MWPHRF certificates issued within the past three years will be accepted for the GPSC class for Invited Boats. This information will be submitted to DRYA by Midnight Tuesday.

DRYA Invited Boats from DRYA member clubs are permitted to enter any class offered but must have a 2024 ORC or MWPHRF certificate and submitted to the GPSC (Regatta Chair Linda Holler (312) 259-7070). All DRYA invited boats shall register on the DRYA website by Tuesday Midnight prior to the regatta at www.drya.org.

All Invited boats racing in a DRYA class shall incur a \$50 fee. The GPSC and the RC will not accept any requests for additions to the scratch sheet after this deadline.
